Fairtrade Policy



1. The school will create and adopt a Fairtrade policy.

Members of the Eco-committee or School Council will take responsibility for implementing the Fairtrade Policy. All staff and pupils will be actively encouraged to support the Fairtrade Policy.

2. Fairtrade products will be available to buy in school.

The school will sell healthy fair-trade snacks. In the long term a fair-trade shop will be established.

3. Fairtrade foods (tea and coffee) will be served at all meetings.

Fairtrade products will be used at meetings hosted by the head, deputy head, governors, head of department meetings, progress evenings and staff coffee mornings.

4. All members of the school will be actively encouraged to use Fairtrade products.

Staff will be actively encouraged to show their commitment to Fairtrade and the ethos behind trade being fair to all through the use of Fairtrade products where possible. Pupils will be encouraged to buy Fairtrade snacks.

5. Fairtrade information will be displayed around the school.

The school will always take an active role during Fairtrade Fortnight (usually the first 2 weeks of March). Staff will be encouraged to discuss Fairtrade during citizenship lessons. There will always be one display board with current Fairtrade information displayed on it.

6. The Schools Eco school policy will incorporate the issues and ethos of Fairtrade

The Eco committee will meet once every half term, the effectiveness and implementation of the Fairtrade policy will always be an agenda item.
